The project is to build a static replica Spitfire to commemorate the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Battle of Britain, and to exhibit the plane at the local Dig for Victory Show next year.

It will be a Community Project, and will provide an Educational Opportunity, as we hope to talk to Local Schools and Community Groups about the project and the Historic Reasons for the Show, together with the opportunity for further research.

The long term benefits will be community adhesion and Education, and hopefully mutual interest, together with the future ability of fundraising for good causes. The final build will become part of the local Historic Vehicles Collection, available for community events and fundraising etc, in the area, and will be stored and maintained by others, but available as required for fundraising events.
