Terms of reference for the village enhancement scheme working group.

Membership

Councillors Hardingham, Booth, Burrows, Johnson, Lansley, McQuillan, Pullin and Sterland.

Areas of responsibility

1. To draw up proposals, for approval by the Parish Council, for a village enhancement scheme as envisaged by the NDP in order to develop a safe, well-designed and attractive environment for the village with a vibrant shopping area; aiming to achieve the following benefits:
 - Reduced traffic speeds
 - Greater safety and independence for pedestrians, especially children
 - Economic regeneration
 - Improved landscaping
 - An identifiable village centre
 - Mitigating the impact of housing and strategic road developments.
2. To consider the extent of the scheme, as to which junctions on the main road and whether to include parts of Keedwell Hill and Lovelinch Gardens.
3. To consult with relevant businesses and residents.
4. To liaise with North Somerset officers and other organisations as appropriate.
5. To obtain indicative costings if necessary.
6. To recommend implementation in segments and/or stages for the purposes of funding and timing.
7. To report back to the Highways Committee.
8. To apply for funding for any part of the scheme from outside organisations
