LONG ASHTON PARISH COUNCIL CODE OF CONDUCT

**Local Government Association Model Councillor Code of Conduct 2020
adopted by the Parish Council on 17th March 2022**

NOTES

Please note that the 2012 Regulations confirm that, a member of a parish council is at risk of prosecution for committing criminal offences in s.34 of the Localism Act 2011 Act if:-

- he/she, without a dispensation, participates or votes on a matter being considered at a meeting in which he/she has a 'disclosable pecuniary interest' (s.31(4) of the 2011 Act) or
- written notification of such disclosable pecuniary interest has not already been given to the Monitoring Officer, and the member does not disclose the disclosable pecuniary interest to the meeting and does not provide written notification of the interest to the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of the meeting (ss.31(2) and (3) of the 2011 Act) or
- he/she knowingly or recklessly provides false or misleading information about the above (s.34(2) of the 2011 Act).

Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a "Sensitive Interest" you need not include that interest provided you have consulted with the Monitoring Officer and he agrees that it need not be included. A "Sensitive Interest" is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk that you or a person connected with you may be subjected to violence or intimidation. Where the interest is no longer a "Sensitive Interest" you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.
